Chief's Report January 10, 2018 Steve Abel, Interim Fire Chief

- 1. Mobilization to Southern California: Our crews returned safely the week before Christmas. We had 2 pieces of damaged equipment:
  - Our type 6 Brush Truck suffered a cracked windshield and a dent in the cab roof while operating in an orchard area. The windshield will be replaced [it was supposed to be replaced today as I prepare this reportbut it's out on another fire]. The cab roof damage is minor and will not be repaired.
  - We damaged [beyond repair] a portable radio that fell from one of our firefighters as they were quickly retreating to a safe area while on the fire line. The radio will need to be replaced- cost about \$2,000.

We have not yet billed for our deployment as the crews and paperwork as they returned and provided paperwork during the holidays.

2. Type 3 Engine: We are still in discussions in getting the needed repairs/modifications completed.

Since this vehicle had been out for a significant time since our last Fire Board meeting, we haven't completely addressed the issues.

The primary issue for us, at this time is the foam system and pump cooling/recirculation system.

I'm still trying to get a handle on all of the issues- at this time I'm led to believe that we cannot use the foam system if we are using a pressurized water source to feed the pump [and if correct, renders the foam system inoperable while water is being supplied via a water tender- such as a structure fire], and it appears that we are not able to get foam to all hose lines.

This is in addition to the issues of foam discharging into the water tank.

This is an active project.

- 3. Audit Update: Relating to issues discussed during the Executive Session at the November 15 meeting, we've advised 'Henry & Horne' to show a '0' balance relating to the vacation accruals in question.
- 4. Cell Phone Services- We now have a Government account with Verizon, which is significantly less expensive than our previous 'Business' account. We now have a 'chief's' cell phone and 2 Ipads that can be used for mobilizations [to complete daily rosters, access mapping data and 'google earth' overviews of the area in which the crews may be assigned. We may eventually utilize Ipads in our vehicles that do not have MDC's for alarm and response information.
- 5. Dispatch and MDC's: In order to transmit alarm information from the County's 'Spillman' dispatch software to our crews, it appears that a new module will need to be added- the cost estimate is \$12,000. This is about ½ of the reported cost for us to be licensed [annually renewed] to fully implement the MDC's. Once we have the firm costs and reassurance that the proposed software will work with one of the 3 alerting programs that we are considering; we'll meet with other agencies to discuss cost sharing, in that the software would be a benefit to all agencies that utilize the dispatch center.
- 6. SAFER Grant: Our grant period is officially set to end in late February. Barbara Cole and I are finalizing the budget numbers in preparation for requesting an extension.
- 7. The old Boardman Pumper is listed for auction.
- 8. I've started on getting FD comparable for the purpose of a salary/wage/benefit survey relating to our staff.
- The FEMA Assistance to Firefighters Grant period is open, and closes on February
   I'm meeting and working with staff to identify our most pressing needs and will submit a grant application.
- 10. I've attached information on HGACBuy- a government cooperative purchasing program. It's no cost to the Fire District to join. Also attached is a listing of current Arizona governmental agencies who participate. The advantage with this program, is that they solicit bids and maintain a listing of current contracts. I've been able use them in the past when purchasing an SCBA air compressor that was funded via a FEMA grant. The co-op met all the FEMA requirements for bidding, and we were able to simplify the purchase. My plan is to have this on the February agenda for Fire Board consideration.
