Chief Maloney had stated that Buckskin Fire leases the property and is not the property owner and they should be in touch with the HOA of that subdivision. ADEQ stated that they wanted to have the Board approve. Board Members discussed and as stated they didn't feel that they should be the ones to approve that ADEQ and would have to have the HOA approve the contract. A motion was made by Wayne Posey to put the agreement back to ADEQ and that Buckskin Fire Board would not be signing the agreement as Buckskin Fire is not the owners of Station 211, there was a second made by John Mihelich.

## Chief's Monthly Report - August 2020

Troy Maloney, Fire Chief

Personnel: All are doing well.

The in-house, State certified Firefighter-1&2 class at station 22 is still going well.

We will be offering free flu shots for all BFD and PFD employees as soon as the County receives them.

<u>Apparatus:</u> 2221 is out of service and in Phoenix for repairs. 2202 and 2251 are listed on Brindlee Mountain Fire Apparatus, LLC for sale.

1101 was out of service for two days for a blown radiator hose that required a Quality Fleet Solutions to send out a mobile repair unit from of Peoria to station 11 to fix. Crews ran out of 1151 and 1131.

On August 26<sup>th</sup>, representatives from Mequiar's Inc, performed a demonstration on Boat-1 of their boat care products and teach us proper care techniques.

1102 has returned from a wildland fire assignment in Wickenburg, AZ.

1132 has returned from a wildland fire assignment in Northern California.

All other apparatus is in service.

<u>Facilities:</u> No major issues or repairs.

Crews at station 11 completed work on the boat house.

<u>Incidents:</u> August 1<sup>st</sup>, at 06:46 hours, 1132, 1131 and 1100 responded to a RV fire on Billy Mack Mine Road. 1100 arrived to find a fully involved RV on fire along with a large amount of debris around it and several small trees. 1100 took command of the incident. 1131 and 1132 arrived and extinguished the fire. No cause for the fire was found and the fire was determined suspicious. LPCSO was on scene.

August 14<sup>th</sup> at 12:07 hours, Boat-1 and 1102 responded to a boating accident in front of Pirates Den with multi victims in the water. Boat-1 arrived to find all persons out of the water, one patient with a leg injury, one sunken boat and a totaled jet ski. Boat-1 took patient care and transported that patient to shore where the crews from 1102 took over care. Boat-1 went back out on the river to search for any other victims; none found. The patient was transported to LPRH by AMR in stable condition.

August 17<sup>th</sup> at 15:00 hours, Tender-1132 dispatched to a wildland fire assignment in Willow, California. Lieutenant Forester is the Engine Boss and Firefighter Kowalski is an Engine Boas Trainee. They are assigned to the August Complex fire.

August 20<sup>th</sup> as 18:00 hours, Engine -1102 (Type-3) was dispatched to a wildland fire assignment in Wickenburg, AZ. Captain Weatherford is the Engine boss. They are assigned to the Constellation Fire and performing structure protection.

August 24<sup>th</sup> at 16:59 hours, 1101, 1102, 1100 and 2203 responded to a structure fire on Treasure Road. 1100 arrived to find a small fire that was out and contained to a laundry room. 1100 canceled 1102 and 2203. 1101 used a TIC (Thermal Imagining Camera) to check for extension; none found. The cause of the fire was undermined and not suspicious.

August 25<sup>th</sup> at 03:55 hours, Boat-1 and 1102 responded to dumpster fire at Echo Lodge near the water. Boat-1 arrived first and extinguished the fire. 1102 canceled.

August 29<sup>th</sup> at 17:06 hours, 1101, 1102 and 1100 responded to Hwy-95 at MP 150 for a self-inflicted gunshot wound to the head. 1100 arrived with LPCSO; 1100 established command and requested a helicopter. 1101 arrived a took patient care of a critical patient. AMR arrived and assisted 1101 with patient care and rapid transport to the LPRH Helo Pad with two BFD personnel on board. 1102 arrived and assisted with scene management while 1100 went to LPRH to pick up BFD personnel. The patient was flown to Phoenix.

August 30<sup>th</sup> at 00:14 hours, 1101 responded to a rattle snake bite. LPRH did not have enough antivenom to take the patient. 1101 requested a helicopter to the scene and 1102 to establish a landing zone.

We were seeing some smoke in our area from the Apple Fire in Cherry Valley California (Riverside County).

<u>Administration:</u> A business in Parker South has request annexation into PFD; we are reviewing their request and looking into the possibility of annexing all of Parker South per the request of the Town of Parker.

August 10<sup>th</sup>, spoke with the Town of Parker Public Works Director about partnering with them on a fire hydrant maintenance program.

August 11<sup>th</sup>, met with the La Paz County Assessor and the Town of Parker Community Development Director.

August 12<sup>th</sup>, met with Captain Bagby of the La Paz County Sheriff's Office to discuss our CAD (Computer Aided Dispatch) system updates.

We are working with the La Paz County Sheriff's Central Dispatch and Parker Police Department to identify properties that are deeded to the Town of Parker to better identify proper jurisdictional responses.

August 17<sup>th</sup>, met Captain Barelli, Sector Commander of the San Diego Coast Guard and his Department Heads for a District tour and response discussion for our area of the Colorado River; they were very pleased with our operation, and cooperation with law enforcement.

August 27<sup>th</sup>, the PFD Fire Board held a special meeting with the Bouse Fire Board to discuss the possibilities of Bouse consolidating into Parker FD. The meeting went very well.

We have been receiving stock of personnel protective equipment (PPE) and hand sanitizer from the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) in preparation of the fall flu season.

We are in the middle of the annual financial audits for both Districts.


