Chief's Monthly Report - February 2021

Troy Maloney, Fire Chief

Personnel: All other personnel are doing well.

All four Station 22 members in our State certified fire academy successfully passed their practical exam which was administered by a State of Arizona Proctor. They are now waiting on the written test results which will be in within the next 30 days.

Apparatus: 2231 is out of service and in Phoenix for repairs.
2251 is listed for sale on Brindlee Mountain Fire Apparatus.

1103 is back in-service.

Brush-11 is out of service. Repairs are in progress.

Boat-1 is out of service and at Nordic for maintenance.

Facilities: No significant issues to report.

Incidents: We are continuing to receive extended ambulance response times from AMR. AMR has been having to send ambulances to the Parker area from Kingman.

Feb 4th at 15:53 hours, 2201 and 1101 responded to a large rubbish fire on Hopi in the Town of Parker. Units arrived to find a large pile of trash burning with no exposures. Units extinguished the fire with a water source from a hydrant several hundred feet away. The cause of the fire was suspicious.

Feb 7th at 14:25 hours, 1101 responded to a transformer fire on Riverside Drive across from JA Johnny's that caused a power outage for approximately 150 residence for a couple hours.

Feb 8th at 00:34 hours, 1102, 1101 and 1100 responded to a three-car accident with injuries on Hwy-95 near River Island State Park. Units arrived to find the vehicles off the roadway and a quarter mile apart. 1102 took care of the patients up-river and 1101 took care of the patients downriver. All patients refused treatment and transport.

Feb 16th at 19:21 hours, 2201, 1101 and 1100 were dispatched to a structure fire with people trapped at the Rivera Apartments on Kofa Ave near Third Street. 1100 requested mutual aid from CRIT Fire. 1100 arrived on scene to find the structure to be a single story, single family dwelling and a vehicle with heavy fire involvement with expose to two other houses. 1100 took command of the incident and confirmed that all occupants were out of the home. 2201 and two CRIT engines arrived on scene shortly after and made a direct attack on the fire. 1101 arrived on scene and conducted an interior search of the building to confirm that there were no victims; none found. The fire was extinguished with approximately 70% of the home being saved including most of the family's possessions. One exposure house did sustain minor damage. No injuries were reported on scene.

Feb 26th at 16:38 hours, 2252 responded to the Parker High School parking lot for an unresponsive infant in a locked car. 2252 arrived, took patient care of an infant in critical condition. AMR had an "unknown" estimated time of arrival and 2252 made a life-saving decision to transport the patient into LPRH in a Parker PD car.

Administration: Feb 22nd, I attended the La Paz County Fire Chiefs meeting which was held at station 44 in Ehrenburg.

2021 Assessed values were released by the La Paz County Assessor's office:
Buckskin - \$67,456,191. This an increase of 4 %.
Parker - \$25,465,127. This an increase of 6 %.

We have started gathering signatures for the Parker South annexation.

We are working on draft budgets for FY 21/22. They will be ready for our budget work sessions.

We have closed out the Parker Volunteer Pension Fund and awaiting final payment from Innis Group so we can cut checks to the participants.

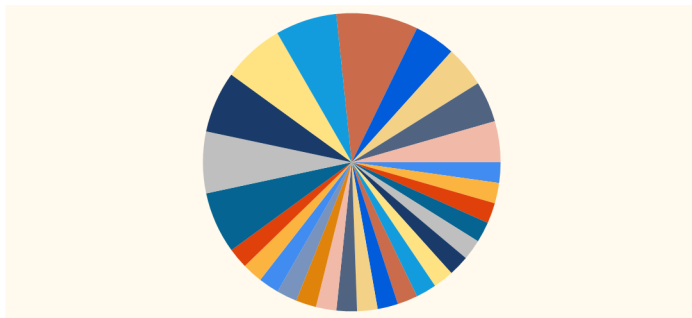
