Pursuant to A.R.S. §38-431.02, notice is hereby given to the members of the Buckskin Fire District Board of Directors and to the general public that the Buckskin Fire District Fire Board will hold a Special Open Meeting, open to the public on **Tuesday, February 24th, 2026, starting at 5:00 pm** in the classroom of the Buckskin Fire District located at: 8500 Riverside Dr., Parker, AZ 85344. The meeting room will be accessible to the public at 4:45 pm. The Buckskin Fire District Fire Board may vote to go into **Executive Session**, which will not be open to the public, for legal advice authorized under A.R.S. §38-431.03. (A)(3). If authorized by a majority vote of the Buckskin Fire District Board of Directors, the executive session will be held immediately after the vote and will not be open to the public.

Agenda

1. Call to Order/Roll Call.
2. **Call to the Public:** Consideration and discussion of comments from the public. *Those wishing to address the Buckskin Fire District Board need not request permission in advance Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.01(I), the Fire District Board is not permitted to discuss or take an action on any item raised in the call to the public that is not specifically identified on the Agenda. However, individual Board members may be permitted to respond to criticism directed at them. Otherwise, the Board may direct that staff review the matter or ask that the matter be placed on a future agenda.* Public input is limited to two (2) minutes unless a greater amount of time is approved by the Board. **The Fire District Board cannot discuss or take legal action on any issue raised during the Call to the Public that is not on the current Agenda, due to restrictions of the Open Meeting Law.**
3. Possible vote to go into Executive Session for legal advice pursuant to A.R.S. §38-431.03. (A)(3); and possible instructions to legal counsel pursuant to A.R.S. §38-431.03. (A)(4), regarding personnel matters; chain of command issues; consulting contract between BFD & JTC Strategic Consulting; the interim Fire Chief appointment; and policy issues.
4. Discussion & Possible Action re: direction from the Fire Board regarding those matters discussed in the Executive Session, including the pending personnel issues; the consulting agreement with JTC Strategic Consulting; the interim Fire Chief appointment; the use of Barbara Cole on an interim basis; a possible future Executive Session under A.R.S. §38-431.03. (A)(1); and related policy issues.

5. Ask Board Members for *items to be considered for inclusion on the next agenda.*

6. Adjourn.
